Customer Education How to run your card: Credit vs. Debit

Reach your rewards faster by selecting Credit instead of Debit when using your LSB Debit Card for purchases.

For every \$6 spent on Debit transactions earn 1 point. For every \$3 spent on Credit transactions earn 1 point.

Debit based transaction require you to enter your PIN.

Credit based transactions are usually when you sign for the transaction and do not require a PIN.

Most stores will vary on how they request payments, some vendors may automatically ask for a PIN while others may ask you which way you would prefer to use your card. However, almost every vendor should have the capabilities to run your card as either Credit or Debit.

If you are unsure of how to run your card for a purchase, ask the store clerk assisting you with the purchase how to run your card.
